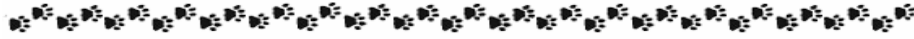

I understand that my failure to comply with the regulations may result in the revocation of my Dog Dining License and a citation from the Town for failure to comply with Town Code. Municipal ordinance violations are subject to local and state statutes, and may result in fines and/or liens against the property owner. I also understand that it is my responsibility to inform the property owner of my application for a Dog Dining License and the implications associated with a failure on my part to comply with the regulations.

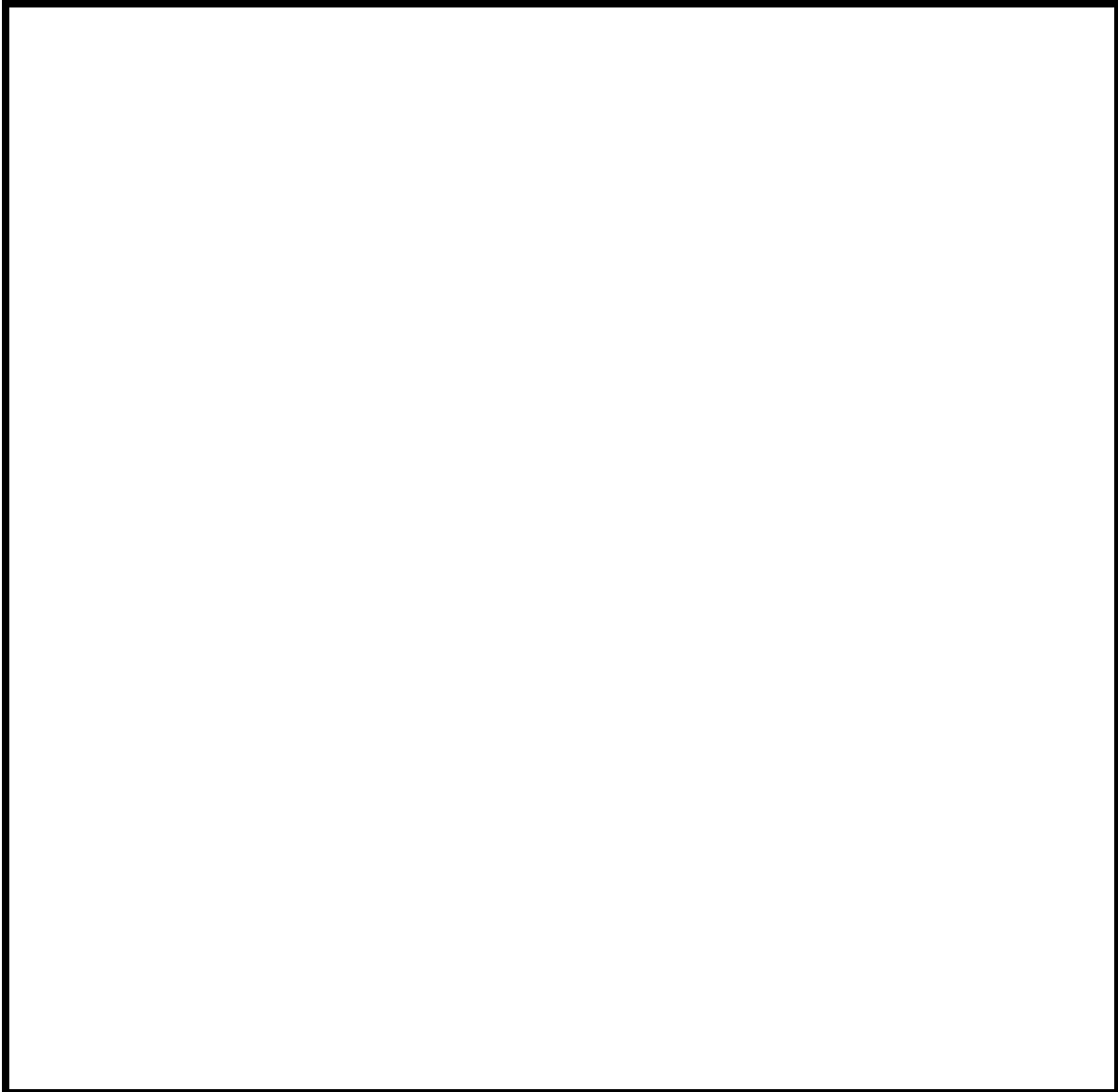

Dog Dining Area Diagram

In the space below or on a separate piece of paper, please provide a diagram (to scale) of the outdoor area showing:

- ⊗ Dimensions of the area, to scale;
- ⊗ A depiction of the number and placement of tables, chairs, and restaurant equipment;
- ⊗ Entryways and exits to the designated outdoor area;
- ⊗ Boundaries of the designated area and, if applicable, outdoor areas not available for patrons' dogs;
- ⊗ Fences or barriers;
- ⊗ Property lines; and
- ⊗ Sidewalks, curbs, public improvements (benches, street lights, street signs, fire hydrants, etc.)

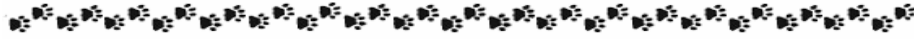


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Dog Dining Regulations



1. Employees shall wash their hands promptly after touching, petting, or otherwise handling any dog(s) and shall wash their hands before entering other parts of the public food service establishment from the designated outdoor area.
2. Employees are prohibited from touching, petting or otherwise handling any dog while serving food or beverages or while handling tableware.
3. Patrons in a designated outdoor area shall be advised that they should wash their hands before eating. Waterless hand sanitizer shall be provided at all tables in the designated outdoor area.
4. Employees and patrons shall not allow dogs to come into contact with serving dishes, utensils, tableware, linens, paper products, or any other items involved with food service operations.
5. Patrons shall keep their dogs on a leash at all times and shall keep their dogs under control.
6. Dogs shall not be allowed on chairs, tables, or other furnishings.
7. All table and chair surfaces shall be cleaned and sanitized between seating of patrons.
8. Dog waste shall be removed immediately and the area immediately cleaned and sanitized with an approved product. A kit with the appropriate materials for this purpose shall be kept near the designated outdoor area.
9. A sign or signs informing employees and patrons of these laws shall be posted on the premises in a manner and place as determined by the Building Official.
10. A sign or signs notifying the public that the designated outdoor area is available for the use of patrons and patrons' dogs shall be posted in a conspicuous manner that places the public on notice.
11. Dogs shall not be permitted to travel through indoor or non-designated outdoor portions of the public food service establishment. Ingress and egress to the designated outdoor area shall not require entrance into or passage through any indoor area of the public food service establishment.
12. A permit issued pursuant to this section shall expire automatically upon the sale of the establishment and cannot be transferred to a subsequent owner. The subsequent owner shall apply for a permit pursuant to this section if the subsequent owner wishes to continue to allow patrons' dogs.
13. A dog dining permit shall be valid for one (1) year but may be renewed on an annual basis. Dog dining permits shall be renewed annually by July 1 and shall expire on June 30 of each year.
14. The application fee for a dog dining permit is \$125.00. This one time fee covers the costs to process the original application, permitting, inspections, renewals, and enforcement.
