

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MELBOURNE BEACH, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2010 FOR THE ELECTION OF TWO TOWN COMMISSIONERS AND A REFERENDUM RELATING TO EVEN YEAR ONLY ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, a general election of candidates for the Office of Town Commissioner and a referendum relating to even year only elections was held pursuant to law on November 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the inspectors and clerks appointed to conduct said election have duly filed their returns of the election as provided by law, and all absentee and provisional ballots cast at said election have been counted as provided by law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commission of the Town of Melbourne Beach, Brevard County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. That the canvassed results for the election of Town Commissioner are as follows:

The total votes cast in said election was 2739, of which number

Gail Gowdy	received <u>574</u> votes	<u>20.96</u> percent
Paul Guglietta	received <u>297</u> votes	<u>10.84</u> percent
Jay Gurecki	received <u>768</u> votes	<u>28.04</u> percent
Stefan Hartmann	received <u>386</u> votes	<u>14.09</u> percent
Rocco Maglio	received <u>714</u> votes	<u>26.07</u> percent

Mr. Jay Gurecki and Mr. Rocco Maglio received the most votes cast in the election for Town Commissioner and is hereby found and declared to be elected to said office.

Section 2. That the canvassed results for the voter approval of even year only elections are as follows:

The total votes cast in said election was 1544 of which number

FOR EVEN YEAR ELECTIONS	received <u>537</u> votes
AGAINST EVEN YEAR ELECTIONS	received <u>1007</u> votes

Section 3. The election was in all respects conducted in accordance with law, all steps in connection with and preceding such election have been duly, regularly and lawfully taken, and all provisions of the *Florida Statutes* and *Constitution of the State of Florida* have been duly complied with.

Section 4. These returns shall be declared as the result of the general election held on November 2, 2010 and entered and recorded in the minutes of the Town Commission; and this

resolution, determination, finding, declaration, and certificate shall be recorded in the minutes of this Town Commission.

Section 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Resolution, or application hereof, is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court, such portion or application shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or application hereof.

Section 6. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
