Dear Resident,

There's a quick test parents can use to find out if their son or daughter is taking drugs, and it's available at the Melbourne Beach Police Department.

The kits can be picked up at the Melbourne Beach Police Department from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday. The kits will be available at a cost of:

- \$8.00 – alcohol tests
- \$8.00 – the basic tests
- \$20.00 – the advanced tests

The Melbourne Beach Police Department believes these screening kits are a good tool to help parents become involved much earlier in the detection of drug use. The fact that the screening kits are self-administered will provide parents with a high degree of privacy and security. Parents can administer the kits and view the results in the privacy of their own home. Melbourne Beach Police will not have access to the results.

The screening kits are a part of a program called LEAD, which stands for Law Enforcement Against Drugs. The kits can screen for the presence of cocaine, marijuana, methamphetamine (speed), morphine, and ecstasy. Parents can also call the LEAD hotline at 1-800-284-5444 for help in interpreting tests and for referrals.
