

RESOLUTION 8-2005

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MELBOURNE BEACH, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; PRIORITY FINDINGS; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER AND/OR THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO OBTAIN A SPECIAL USE OF STATE ROAD/TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSING PERMITS FOR THE TOWN AND AUTHORIZING THEM TO PERFORM ANY OTHER ACTS PURSUANT TO FDOT RULE CHAPTER 14-65; PROVIDING FOR THE TOWN CLERK TO PREPARE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE TOWN COMMISSION MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2005 THAT AUTHORIZED THE ANNUAL CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS PARADE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Melbourne Beach has authorized an annual Children's Christmas Parade in the past; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to authorize such parade for the year 2005

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF MELBOURNE BEACH, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and by this reference are hereby incorporated into and made an integral part of this Resolution

Section 2. The Town Commission of the Town of Melbourne Beach hereby authorizes the Children's Christmas Parade to be held at/on Ocean Avenue, Melbourne Beach on either of the following dates: December 10, 2005 or December 11, 2005.

Section 3. The Town Commission authorizes either the Town Manager or the Chief of Police to sign any and all documents and papers required by the Florida Department of Transportation to conduct the parade and to obtain a permit for temporary closure of State Road A1A at Oak Street, Melbourne Beach.


Section 4. The Town Commission finds that the temporary closing of such road is necessary for the Children's Christmas Parade.

Section 5. The Town Manager and/or the Chief of Police are hereby authorized to include all information necessary and required in the request submitted to FDOT for such temporary closing.


Section 6. To the extent permitted by Florida law the Town will assume full responsibility for any liability claims arising from, or based on, the activities of the parade.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

This Resolution was duly passed and adopted at the November 2, 2005 Special Meeting of the Town Commission of the Town of Melbourne Beach, Brevard County, Florida, on the 2nd day of November 2005.
