







COVID Key Points

- 63% of eligible Brevard County residents have received at least one vaccine dose
 - [FDOH Weekly Report](#)
- COVID cases continue to increase but are no longer doubling, as seen in previous weeks
- Primary concern is the functionality of our hospitals and health care systems
 - Hospitals continue to operate in a surge
- Testing availability is a significant challenge
 - DOH and EM are working with partners to increase community testing availability
- CDC has approved a booster shot to people with severely compromised immune systems
 - [Immunocompromised criteria](#)
 - At this time booster shots are not recommended for any other population
 - DOH and other vaccine facilities are starting to give out the booster shot for Pfizer and Moderna



Brevard County Monoclonal Antibody (mAb) COVID Treatment Site

- Brevard County partnered with the State of Florida to operate a walk-up mAb treatment site at Kiwanis Island Park in Merritt Island
- The goal of the treatment is keep COVID positive individual's symptoms at the medium to mild level therefore reducing the number of people who require hospitalization
- Eligibility for treatment:
 - 12 years of age and older
 - Individuals who are COVID positive or are experiencing COVID symptoms
 - Have been exposed to someone who is COVID positive and are at risk for severe illness due to COVID 19
 - No referrals or doctor's notes necessary
 - Vaccination status does not matter
- Schedule appointments www.patientportalfl.com
 - Appointments are preferred
 - Walk-ups are being accepted at this time
- Treatment is free
 - Individuals will be asked for their insurance but it is not required to receive treatment
- From 12PM Tuesday through the end of today, the site has administered 583 treatments
