



## **January 2018 Monthly Report:**

During the month of January our officers once again were able to keep our crime activity low. Our officers use all tools available, from Community Policing, to aggressive pro-active tactics to prevent crime in our Town. The month of January we had zero business burglary, zero vehicle burglary and one residential burglary. I also come in on nights and will continue to assist with being pro-active and reduce our crime. We conducted several traffic enforcement details throughout the Town, due to resident complaints, and issued 15 traffic citations. One D.U.I. arrest.

Animal Complaints, we had 2 calls this month. The majority of our animal complaints consist of stray, loose or injured pets, dogs in the Park or on the beach. These complaints also include calls for poisonous snakes, raccoons, etc.

Areas with a high volume calls for service are Injured or ILL persons. These types of calls are unpredictable in nature. Our Officers are First Responders and are first on scene with a medical call and are certified to perform CPR and A.E.D.

I do not see any type of trend on any major crime in the Town. I can tell you that all calls for service and crime are looked at every day and analyzed by myself or a supervisor. Depending on the type of crime we have, procedures are in place to take appropriate action to resolve the issue. I assure the residents that our Town is protected 24/7 and we will use all resources available to us to keep our Town safe and are committed to keeping a low crime rate.

**MONTHLY REPORT FOR (JAN 2018)**

**01/01 – W/M Baker Act 400 block of Fourth Ave. Wife stated he was acting strange and said she wasn't his wife. Threatened to stab anyone that came to the house.**

**01/01 – Traffic Crash in the parking lot next to Dijon's. Vehicle backed into an unoccupied parked vehicle.**

**01/02 – Traffic Crash at Oak St and Sunset Blvd. V1 traveling too close in adverse conditions and couldn't stop in time behind V2 who was stopped in traffic and struck the rear of the vehicle. No injuries or air bag deployments.**

**01/11 – DUI 200 block of Fifth Ave. Homeowner found a vehicle parked in his driveway running with a w/f passed out at the wheel and the vehicle not in park. Defendant refused FSE's and also breath test and was subsequently arrested for Driving Under the Influence.**

**01/16 – Verbal Domestic at the 200 block of Sixth Ave. Mother and son having a verbal argument about him being grounded for quitting his job.**

**01/19 – Felony Criminal Mischief 1500 block of Atlantic St. Suspect kicked in door, went upstairs and kicked both toilet water supply lines and left. The condo filled with water causing the ceiling to fall and water damage throughout the condo. Damage is well into the tens of thousands of dollars. Case turned over to Det Sgt Griswold with one possible suspect.**

**01/19 – Traffic Crash in parking lot of 300 Ocean Ave. Vehicle backed into another vehicle. Minimal damage and a driver's exchange was completed.**

**01/26 – Attempted Suicide at the 1800 block of Redwood Ave. Juvenile found by friend with belt around his neck. Juvenile transported to Holmes and then Baker Acted.**

**01/27 – Traffic Crash at Oak St and Colony St. Vehicle driving too close rear ended vehicle in front of him. Minimal damage and a driver's exchange was completed.**

- 01/04- Burglary to an unoccupied residence in the 2200 block of Atlantic Street. Suspect(s) forced open the front door to the residence and stole electronics and money from inside. No named suspects at this time, however possible photos were taken from a similar burglary that occurred in Indialantic.
- 01/07- Baker Act of a juvenile female in the 2100 block of Atlantic Street.
- 01/07- Overdose and Baker Act of a female in the 1500 block of Oak Street. Female is expected to be ok.
- 01/12- Traffic Arrest of a male for driving with no license ever issued at Oak Street and Orange Street. Vehicle was stopped for not having a license plate.
- 01/13- Domestic verbal dispute between parents and their teenage daughter in the 2100 block of Atlantic Street.
