

March 2018 Monthly Report:

During the month of March our officers once again were able to keep our crime activity low. Our officers use all tools available, from Community Policing, to aggressive pro-active tactics to prevent crime in our Town. The month of March we had zero business burglary, zero vehicle burglary and one residential burglary. I also come in on nights and will continue to assist with being pro-active and reduce our crime. We conducted several traffic enforcement details throughout the Town, due to resident complaints, and issued 9 traffic citations, one D.U.I. arrest and 11 parking citations.

Animal Complaints, we had 6 calls this month. The majority of our animal complaints consist of stray, loose or injured pets, dogs in the Park or on the beach. These complaints also include calls for poisonous snakes, raccoons, etc.

Areas with a high volume calls for service are Injured or ILL persons. These types of calls are unpredictable in nature. Our Officers are First Responders and are first on scene with a medical call and are certified to perform CPR and A.E.D.

I do not see any type of trend on any major crime in the Town. I can tell you that all calls for service and crime are looked at every day and analyzed by myself or a supervisor. Depending on the type of crime we have, procedures are in place to take appropriate action to resolve the issue. I assure the residents that our Town is protected 24/7 and we will use all resources available to us to keep our Town safe and are committed to keeping a low crime rate.

MONTHLY REPORT FOR (MARCH 2018)

03/05 – Traffic Crash at Exxon 904 Oak St. Vehicle pulled out of east side of parking lot and turned left to travel north on Oak St and pulled in front of a southbound vehicle on Oak St.

03/06 – Death in the 300 block of Hibiscus Tr. Elderly woman found on floor in kitchen by family. No suspicious activity found, DR signed death certificate.

03/07 – Baker Act in the 200 block of Sixth Ave. W/M son threatened father. Transported to Circles of Care.

03/07 - Theft at Exxon. H/M stole candy and when approached threw the candy back at employee. H/M was trespassed from the premises.

03/07 – Fire in the 300 block of First Ave. Possibly started by a thrown lit cigarette from one of the residents. MBVFD and IFD responded and took over scene.

03/15 – Assist DCF at the 1900 block of Rosewood Dr. We have been receiving numerous calls by the homeowner to respond to her address in reference to all unusual things happening near or in her house. DCF was called and responded to check on her since family will not.

03/15 – Traffic Crash at 324 Ocean Ave. 2 vehicles stopped in traffic were hit by another vehicle that did not stop in time. All vehicles received minor damage and no injuries.

03/16 – 2 juveniles ran from officer at Sixth Ave and Pine St. 1 juvenile stopped but the other continued and was not located. 30 minutes later, the missing juvenile was at a friend's house and that friend's mother called the juvenile's mother. We made contact with both juveniles and all parents and explained how serious the situation was and that they could be charged with a felony. The juveniles stated their parents didn't know they were out and were meeting "boys" at Ryckman Park. Both juveniles and parents stated it would never happen again.

03/23 – W/F arrested at Sand on the Beach for a warrant out of IRCSO. Officers responded for an unruly person and discovered a warrant was out for her arrest.

03/23 – Domestic Disturbance at the 1800 block of Atlantic St. Mother and daughter in an argument about the mother finding marijuana in the daughter's bedroom. Daughter stated her arm was broken and a social worker called us and DCF. Investigation showed daughter's arm was at most hyper extended from the mother trying to stop her from hitting her. Marijuana was put in evidence for destruction, DCF was notified and report will be sent to the Domestic Violence Center. No physical battery occurred.

03/24 – Traffic Crash at 804 Oak St. V2 was slowing due to traffic backing up and V1 did not stop in time and crashed into V2.

3/24 – Death at the 700 block of Atlantic St. Elderly male with medical issues passed away. No foul play was involved. ME was called and stated to turn body over to funeral home.

03/30 – Traffic Crash at Atlantic St and Sixth Ave. V2 was slowing down for traffic stopped and V1 did not stop in time and collided with V2.
