

#### **April 2018 Monthly Report:**

During the month of April our officers once again were able to keep our crime activity low. Our officers use all tools available, from Community Policing, to aggressive pro-active tactics to prevent crime in our Town. The month of April we had zero business burglary, zero vehicle burglary and zero residential burglary. I also come in on nights and will continue to assist with being pro-active and reduce our crime. We conducted several traffic enforcement details throughout the Town, due to resident complaints, and issued 18 traffic citations, zero D.U.I. arrest and 5 parking citations.

Animal Complaints, we had 4 calls this month. The majority of our animal complaints consist of stray, loose or injured pets, dogs in the Park or on the beach. These complaints also include calls for poisonous snakes, raccoons, etc.

Areas with a high volume calls for service are Injured or ILL persons. These types of calls are unpredictable in nature. Our Officers are First Responders and are first on scene with a medical call and are certified to perform CPR and A.E.D.

I do not see any type of trend on any major crime in the Town. I can tell you that all calls for service and crime are looked at every day and analyzed by myself or a supervisor. Depending on the type of crime we have, procedures are in place to take appropriate action to resolve the issue. I assure the residents that our Town is protected 24/7 and we will use all resources available to us to keep our Town safe and are committed to keeping a low crime rate.

# **SERGEANT DOVALE**

#### **MONTHLY REPORT FOR (APRIL 2018)**

04/01 – Fraud at the 500 block of Sunset Blvd. Unknown suspect placed residence on Craigslist for rent. House is occupied, victim is getting reimbursed through their bank. No suspect information can be ascertained.

04/01 – Domestic Violence/Disturbance at the 2000 block of Oak St. Grandson arguing with grandfather and pushed him.

04/01 – Missing Juvenile/Baker Act at the 2000 block of Oak St. Juvenile had argument with grandparents then left the residence. An extensive search throughout the night was conducted including bloodhounds. Juvenile returned home at 2am and made statements about not wanting to live and was subsequently placed in a Baker Act.

04/06 – Traffic Crash at Oak St and Sunset Blvd. V2 following too closely and did not stop in time for slowing traffic and crashed into V1 causing V2 to hit another vehicle.

04/06 – Traffic Crash at Ocean Ave and Orange St. V2 stopped in traffic and V1 did not stop in time and crashed into V2.

04/06 – Trespass at the 1200 block of Atlantic St. W/M drove to residence and tried to tell his mother's ex-boyfriend's new girlfriend that he is abusive and to beware of him. Responded to W/M's residence and trespassed him.

04/09 – Verbal Disturbance at the 200 block of Sixth Ave. Numerous calls to the residence reference the son yelling and screaming when phone is taken or doesn't get what he wants. Son has Autism and other health conditions.

04/14 – Traffic Crash at Oak St and First Ave. V1 tried crossing over Oak St from First Ave and collided with V2 travelling south on Oak St.

04/14 – Hit and Run Traffic Crash at Oak St and Ocean Ave. Witnesses following suspect from Melbourne watching vehicle leaving road throughout multiple cities. V1 crashed into speed limit sign at the southwest corner of Oak St/Ocean Ave and kept going. V1 continued south on Oak St and left the road, crossing over the northbound lane and struck Waste Pro garbage cans. V1 came to rest on the side of the road at 2003 Oak St with a flat tire and other vehicle damage. BCFR responded and advised he had an extremely low blood sugar count. He was treated and refused transport. Driver was cited and given a court date for Leaving the Scene of an Accident with Damage.

04/15 – Possible Suicide Attempt in the 1400 block of Pine St. Victim used a small utility knife to make superficial wounds to his left wrist and forearm. Victim was transported to Holmes Regional and a Baker Act was completed.

04/25 – Officer was informed at school zone about a possible fight that was about to take place at Flutie Field. School representatives had thought they had taken care of the issue earlier, but kids were noticed crossing the street to the field after school. Officers responded and made sure there were no disturbances and spoke to teachers, assistant principal and parents to make sure it didn't happen and wouldn't happen in the future.
