## **Melbourne Beach Police Department**



In the month of June, we had a total of 9 arrests. 5 Misdemeanors and 4 Felonies that range from traffic to warrant arrests. 3 Deaths investigations; one attended, one unattended, and one suicide. House checks/ residential and business checks are continued on a daily basis.

The officers and I continue to be proactive as they conducted several traffic enforcement details throughout the town, and we respond to residential complaints and have issued 33 traffic citations, one DUI w/ property damage, and three parking citations.

Animal complaints, we had eight calls this month. They range from loose, lost or found dogs to a snake in a house.

Our areas of high volume calls consist of Injured/ILL persons. These calls are unpredictable, but each of our officers is First Responders/CPR/AED certified and are first on the scene to provide medical treatment as necessary.

All reports and calls for service are checked each day by either myself or a supervisor. Depending on the type of crime we have, procedures are in place to take the appropriate action to resolve the issue.

The Melbourne Beach Police Officers and I are committed to community policing and keeping our town safe which is our #1 priority.

Attached you will see a brief overview of the Sergeants monthly report that highlights some of our arrests and calls for service.

#### **MONTHLY REPORT FOR (JUNE 2018)**

06/01 – Traffic Crash at 904 Oak St. Vehicle 1 driver backed out of a parking spot at Exxon and backed into a vehicle at a gas pump. No injuries. Driver of vehicle 1 cited for improper backing.

06/02 – Possible Theft 200 block of Sixth Ave. Homeowner stated her deceased husband's Rolex has been missing since December. Unknown what happened, but stated many people had been through the residence. Her insurance company for the watch needed a report completed.

06/03 – Open House Party in the area of Acacia Blvd and Hibiscus Tr. Party just started with underage drinking. Homeowner's daughter invited friends over. Her mother arrived and had everyone leave. No intoxicated people at house. Mother took her daughter and friends home with her.

06/03 – Possible Theft 200 block of Birch Ave. Homeowner stated her iPad has been missing for a week and believed it was a relative. We spoke to a relative who denied it and told her to track it through her account. Victim stated she wanted a report so she could file it with her homeowner's insurance.

06/03 – Hit and Run crash at Atlantic St and Fifth Ave. Driver of vehicle stated she was waiting to make a left onto Fifth Ave to head west and a vehicle went around her northbound in the southbound lane of Atlantic St causing damage to the left front quarter panel. After questioning that the damage didn't coincide with her story, the driver stated that her deductible was higher than the amount of damage and didn't want to complete the report.

06/04 – Suicide at the 300 block of Second Ave. Victim hung himself in the bathroom stall. BCSO Homicide was called and case was turned over to them.

06/09 – H/F arrested for Driving While License Suspended. Released with a court date and picked up by a licensed driver.

06/10 – W/M arrested for Driving While License Suspended. Florida tag also seized.

06/10 – Possible Fraud 1708 Atlantic. W/M stating W/F who works for him stealing money from his account and left the scene. Highly intoxicated decided didn't want our help.

06/17 – W/M arrested at the Oasis Bar for a felony warrant.

06/18 – Suspicious Package at the library. Aluminum briefcase on bench out front. No one in the library claimed ownership so area was evacuated and BCSO Bomb Squad was called. The sight was cleared a few hours later because all that was found was a MacBook. The owner who lives in Indialantic was notified.

06/18 – Missing Endangered Adults. The son of the parents called to advise they hadn't been home for 12 hours. The parents did state at some time they were going to drive back to Putnam County where they used to live. A statewide BOLO was put out and a hit came back immediately that Volusia County had stopped out with them on 195 because they ran out of gas and that Putnam County was out with them at a hotel at this time. The son drove to the scene and brought his parents back home. The parents are not in danger, they just wanted to be left alone from other family members. DCF was called by an anonymous person and the husband became angry. DCF advised they were going to file a petition to get him evaluated.

06/20 – Traffic Crash at 401 Ocean Ave. Vehicle backing up did not see another vehicle properly parked in a parking spot. Damage to both vehicles, but no injuries.

06/21 – Hit and Run at 801 Pine St. Vehicle left the road, struck and knocked over mailbox. Witness located officer with description of vehicle.

06/21 – DUI at Andrews Dr and Pine St. Vehicle was involved in a hit and run when officer located it at the above address, the driver was inside vehicle in the southbound lane heading northbound. DUI Investigation completed and W/F arrested for DUI, DUI with property damage, leaving the scene of an accident with property damage, marijuana and driving while license suspended without knowledge.

06/27 – Warrant Arrest at 400 block of Coral Ave. Teletype advised of a possible felony warrant. Officers made contact with w/f suspect, confirmed warrant, arrested and turned her over to jail van.

06/28 – Petit Theft at 2150 Atlantic St. Victim stated someone stole all of her solar lights in front of her residence. No suspect information, but may have been a condo association violation that was ignored. Board members stated they did not take them, although there was a copy of a 2nd notice of violations addressed to her.

06/28 – Traffic Crash at Ocean Ave and Orange St. V1 did not stop in time and collided with bumper of V2, who was stopped at the crosswalk. Both vehicles sustained minor damage and a drivers exchange was completed.
