

Melbourne Beach Police Department Monthly Report

December 2018



In the month of December, we had a total of 516 calls for service and 7 criminal charges. 4 Felony and 3 Misdemeanor that ranged from Battery, Grand Theft, Lewd and Lascivious, Resisting without violence, Driving Under the Influence and Leaving the Scene of a Traffic Crash.

House checks/ residential and business checks are continued on a daily basis. The officers and I continue to be proactive as they conducted several "directed traffic enforcement details" throughout the town.

We had 4 animal complaints this month consisting of loose dogs and dogs on the beach which were gone upon officers arrival.

Our areas of high volume calls consist of Injured/ILL persons. These calls are unpredictable, and each of the officers is First Responder/CPR/AED certified and is first on the scene to provide medical treatment as necessary.

All reports and calls for service are checked each day by either myself or a supervisor. Depending on the type of crime we have, procedures are in place to take the appropriate action to resolve the issue.

Our SRO Alex Vila joined some of the Gemini 6th graders in reading Dr Seuss "How the Grinch Stole Christmas." He continues to promote positive reinforcement to students, parents, and teachers when needed. The Melbourne Beach Police Officers and I are committed to community policing and keeping our town safe which is our #1 priority.

I want to thank all of the residents and businesses that brought us cookies and goodies over the holiday season, and we are very grateful for the Christmas cards and kind words from all.

I would also like to thank all of the volunteers of The Melbourne Beach Volunteer Fire Department and the participants for another great year of the Children's Christmas Parade.

Attached you will see a brief overview of the Sergeants monthly report that highlights some of our calls for service and a Special Recognition to Sergeant Smith and Corporal Jason Hinchman.
