

# Melbourne Beach Police Department Monthly Report April 2019



In the month of April, we had a total of 4 criminal charges. 3 Felony and 1Misdemeanor that ranged from a Residential Burglary, Fraud, and Grand Theft to Criminal Mischief, with one arrest from a Domestic Violence.

House checks/residential and business checks are continued daily. The officers and I continue to be proactive as they conducted several "directed traffic enforcement details" throughout the town. Our radar trailer is also placed in various locations throughout the city to assist in deterring speeders.

We had two animal complaints/calls this month consisting of a deceased animal and a service dog on the beach.

Our areas of high volume calls consist of Injured/Ill persons. These calls are unpredictable, and each of the officers is First Responder/CPR/AED certified and is first on the scene to provide medical treatment as necessary.

All reports and calls for service are checked each day by either myself or a supervisor. Depending on the type of crime we have, procedures are in place to take the appropriate action to resolve the issue.

Our SRO Alex Vila continues to promote positive reinforcement to students, parents, and teachers when needed at Gemini Elementary. He met with Deputy Chief Brown and me regarding stop the bleed kits in all classrooms and funding for it.

Sgt. Smith has completed his 80 hr course of Instructor Techniques offered at EFSC. He is currently
working on in house training of the officers on various topics and will be giving a presentation to St.
Sebastian Church on safety.

- I want to extend a thank you to PW Supervisor Tom Davis and his staff for the installation of the rear parking lot gate. Not only is this part of what is needed to become accredited. It also assists in keeping the public safe from wondering in this area.
- Sgt. Dovale has been working closely with FDLE and Computer Experts on a Technical Audit. The
  audit is State and Countywide, and we are making a mandatory change to comply with FDLE's
  policies and the FBI. We forecast these changes for better security and updated policies within our
  department to be completed by October 2019.
- I have been diligently working on changing the format and updating our SOP's to explain the organization, its policies, and procedures of the Melbourne Beach Police Department (MBPD).
- April 10<sup>th</sup> we celebrated Administrative Assitant Appreciation Day by honoring Amber who I am
  very grateful to have. Her knowledge and contributions make our department a success.

The Melbourne Beach Police Officers and I are committed to community policing and keeping our town safe which is our #1 priority.

04/27 – Domestic Battery at the 300 block of Third Ave. Girlfriend and boyfriend living together were in a physical altercation. The girlfriend was arrested for Battery Domestic Violence.
